# VOCAL

All students must complete the application at [magnet.ccsd.net](https://magnet.ccsd.net) by January 9, 2024. Applications entered after the deadline are considered late and will be scheduled for the late audition and only if a seat in the requested conservatory is available. ## AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Major scale ascending/descending (D Major for Basses and Altos, F Major for sopranos and tenors). \*Can be on solfege syllables or neutral syllables.
2. Solo song of choice (musical theater, aria, art song, folk song). Select a one (1) minute solo to show off your vocal strengths.
  - You must bring sheet music or an accompaniment track (MP3 on a phone, tablet, or laptop).
  - An accompanist will be provided.
  - You may not “sing-along” with another singer on a track.
  - You are not allowed to sing popular, R & B, rap, or top 40 music.
  - A cappella is not allowed.
3. Rhythmic/Melodic Sight-Reading

All students must complete the application at [magnet.ccsd.net](https://magnet.ccsd.net) by January 9, 2024.

Parents/Guardians will receive an audition confirmation email prior to the audition containing their student's magnet confirmation number. Students must bring/show electronically a copy of the audition confirmation email to check in on the day of their audition.
