AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: Student must bring:

I. Portfolio Submission:

- a. Please bring a representative sample of your work to the interview.
- b. This may include but is not limited to: artwork, sewing projects, carpentry pieces, crafts, in-scale renderings, models, 3-D creations, technology-based original designs, and stage management books.
- **Presentation of Work:**
 - a. During the interview, you will be expected to present and discuss your submitted work.
 - **b.** Accompany your presentation with documentation that traces the evolution of your project from inception to completion. This should encompass:
 - i. Inspirational notes or images that guided your work.
 - ii. Process photographs or records illustrating the development of your piece.

Discussion and Q&A:

Be prepared to answer questions about:

- a. The inspiration behind your work.
- b. The processes you undertook.
- c. Materials utilized.
- d. The intended function or use of your project.
- ** Theater experience is not required to audition.

All students must complete the application at magnet.ccsd.net by January 9, 2024. Parents/Guardians will receive an audition confirmation email prior to the audition containing their student's magnet confirmation number. Students must bring/show electronically a copy of the audition confirmation email to check in on the day of their audition.
