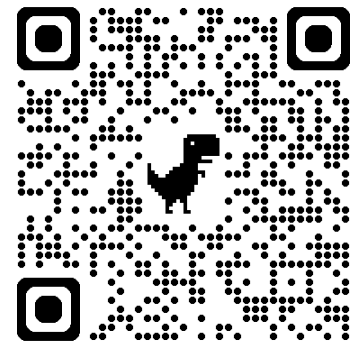

- 7:30am – 8:15am: **Check-in** (PAC Theater) – Registration
→ Students wanting to run for a Student Council position will turn in their copy of their report card, typed resume, and typed paragraph. Interviews will happen at the end of the Orientation day from 2:30pm-3:00pm.
- 8:00am – 11:00am: **Parent Meetings** (Lowden Theater & Main building) – Parents have an informational meeting with administration in the Lowden Theater, then proceed to the Main building for a variety of meetings with the counseling department.

- *Copy of the most recent grade report card (In order to qualify, you must have a G.P.A. of at least 2.5, and must NOT be carrying an “F” grade, or “U” in conduct/citizenship.)*
- *Typed paragraph response detailing what “Leadership” means to you.*
- *A typed resume (including your work/volunteer experience)*
- *Interviews for Student Council will be held immediately after orientation (2:30pm – 3:00pm)*

****If chosen to be a Student Council Representative, you are REQUIRED to enroll in the Principles of Leadership elective class.**
