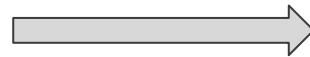

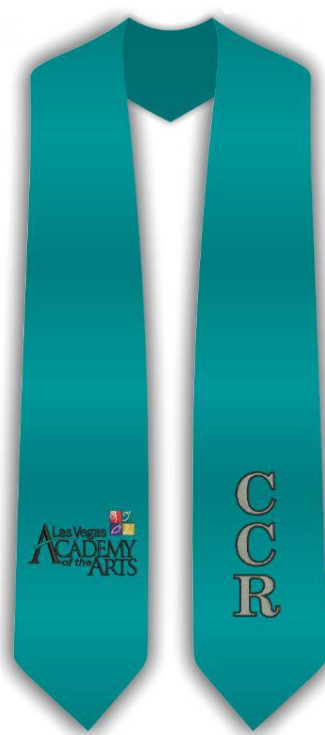

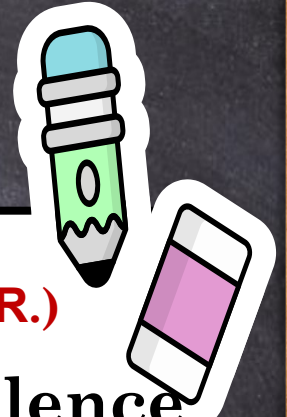

 - **All classes are full year—balance is important**
 - **No schedule changes in August**
 - **Can't drop or add classes due to change of heart**
 - Add **FOUR** elective choices - make sure you are interested in these classes
 - Consider Student Worker - paid position **\$10.50** an hour
- Meet with your counselor between 2/8–3/10
- Enjoy Spring break March 13 - 17
- **Submit all forms (DEADLINE March 31st)**
 - Challenge form is required for all **CORE changes** (up to 3 classes on one form) **Approved courses are irreversible.**

ELECTIVE OPTIONS



- SELECT CTE COURSES THAT WILL GIVE YOU COLLEGE CREDITS AND FULFILL COX DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS
- SOPHOMORES GET ONE ELECTIVE OPTION - SELECT 2ND LEVEL OF A CTE OR LANGUAGE COURSE WHEN POSSIBLE
- PE-II WILL BE ON YOUR SCHEDULE UNTIL THE CREDIT IS POSTED
- PE-II WAIVER CAN BE EARNED IF YOU'VE BEEN A PART OF A TEAM FOR A SEASONAL SPORT IN YOUR CCSD ZONE SCHOOL - SEE YOUR COUNSELOR FOR DETAILS
- DO NOT SELECT ANY AUDITION ELECTIVE COURSES ON YOUR COURSE SELECTION-IF YOU AUDITION AND MAKE THE CUT, IT WILL BE IN YOUR SCHEDULE
- EVEN THOUGH FOREIGN LANGUAGE IS NOT A GRADUATION REQUIREMENT-IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT STUDENTS TAKE 2-YEARS OF ANY LANGUAGE TO BE COMPETITIVE WHEN APPLYING FOR COLLEGES OUTSIDE OF NEVADA
- IF YOU HAVE BEEN APPROVED FOR A MINOR - YOU WILL HAVE 2 BLOCKS (4 CLASSES). IF YOUR MINOR CONFLICTS WITH YOUR MAJOR BLOCK, IT WILL BE DROPPED
