- SELECT CTE COURSES THAT WILL GIVE YOU COLLEGE CREDITS AND FULFILL CC DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS
- SOPHOMORES GET ONE ELECTIVE OPTION - SELECT 2ND LEVEL OF A CTE OR LANGUAGE COURSE WHEN POSSIBLE
- PE-II WILL BE ON YOUR SCHEDULE UNTIL THE CREDIT IS POSTED
- PE-II WAIVER CAN bE EARNED IF YOU'VE BEEN A PART OF A TEAM FOR A SEASONAL SPORT IN YOUR CCSD ZONE SCHOOL - SEE YOUR COUNSELOR FOR DETAILS
- DO NOT SELECT ANY AUDITION ELECTIVE COURSES ON YOUR COURSE SELECTION-IF YOU AUDITION AND MAKE THE CUT, IT WILL BE IN YOUR SCHEDULE
- EVEN THOUGH FOREIGN LANGUAGE IS NOT A GRADUATION REQUIREMENT-IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT STUDENTS TAKE 2-YEARS OF ANY LANGUAGE TO BE COMPETITIVE WHEN APPLYING FOR COLLEGES OUTSIDE OF NEVADA
- IF YOU HAVE BEEN APPROVED FOR A MINOR - YOU WILL HAVE 2 BLOCKS (4 CLASSES). iF YOUR MINOR CONFLICTS WITH YOUR MAJOR BLOCK, IT WILL BE DROPPED
