



# *LVA Dress Code*

## **Appropriate Attire for LVA Students**

The LVA administration encourages students and parents to be familiar with and comply with the official [CCSD Dress and Appearance regulation 5131](#). Below are CCSD Dress & Appearance Regulations as interpreted by LVA students and faculty to meet the needs of Las Vegas Academy of the Arts students.

Students will be referred immediately to the **Character & Compliance Office** for non-compliance with any of the following:

1. Hats and other headwear must allow the face to be visible and not interfere with the line of sight of any student or staff. In the classroom, hoodies and caps must allow the student face and ears to be visible to staff.
2. Clothing with text or imagery that states, implies, or depicts hate targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or religious identity is not permitted.
3. Clothing may not depict pornography, nudity, sexual acts, use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, other controlled substances, or gang identifiers.
4. Clothing must not threaten the health or safety of any student or staff.
5. Shirts/tops must cover the belly button; strapless not permitted. Low-cut will be defined as the shirt/top material should go from the bottom of one armpit across to the other armpit to avoid being considered "low-cut".
6. Pants/shorts must fully cover the buttocks whether sitting, squatting, or walking.
7. Fabric covering all private parts must not be see-through.

## **Consequences:**

1st infraction	<b>Change Attire &amp; Warning</b>
2nd infraction	<b>Change Attire, Phone Parent &amp; Detention</b>
3rd infraction	<b>Change Attire, RPC &amp; 2X Detention</b>
4th infraction	<b>Change Attire, In-House Suspension for Insubordination, Behavior Contract for refusal to follow rules</b>
5th infraction	<b>Change Attire, Suspension for Insubordination, and Placed on Non-Return List</b>
6th infraction	<b>Change Attire, Suspension for Insubordination &amp; Recommended Removal from LVA for Habitual Disregard of School Rules</b>

Additionally, school ID badge must always be prominently displayed around the neck or attached to a front belt loop (beginning on school picture day).
