Opportunities To Get Yourself Out There

- Students must self-report community service hours. LVA Students can earn up to 1 credit on their transcript (120 hours)
- Students can volunteer at any local non-profit, house of worship, government agency or school. (Hours completed for volunteer classes, school clubs, and other volunteer programs can count toward their hours of service)
- Students must have a volunteer supervisor (that is not a relative) verify their service.

- Complete CCSD Community Service Program Volunteering Student Summary Sheet
- Finally, return both forms to your Counselor (Volunteer Service will get added to your transcript).
