- YOU!
  - You should always know what is on your transcript!
- Your counselor
  - We look at them at least once every year and by senior year multiple times!
- Your insurance agent
  - Your GPA influences your insurance rate on your car!
- Your parents
- College Admissions
  - Low GPAs mean no admissions.
  - All colleges ask for them and even conservatories will look at them.

# When do you get a transcript

- You receive a transcript during preregistration.
  - When we meet for our one-on-one, your counselor will do a credit check.
- Once you are a junior, a credit check will be done in the fall and at preregistration.
- Senior year, you will get one in the fall and after 7<sup>th</sup> semester.
- You can request one at any time for insurance purposes, jobs, summer programs, or whatever!
  - See the registrar or Ms. Laura if you need one!

# Types of Transcripts

### Unofficial

- Student comes in and asks for it from the counselor or counselor's secretary
- Printed on regular paper and just handed to student.
  - Summer Business
    Institute
  - Insurance Purposes

### Official

- Request on Naviance
  - Printed on special paper
  - Raised seal
  - Signed by registrar
  - Sealed in an envelope
  - (if seal is broken, then becomes unofficial)
    - College applications
    - Scholarships

### GPA Definitions

- Unweighted GPA
  - This is based on a 4.0 grading scale
  - Add up all your grades and divide by the number of classes
- Weighted GPA
  - The state of Nevada limits to 28 semesters of Honors/AP/IB
  - You get 0.050 for AP added to your GPA
  - You get 0.0250 for honors added to your GPA
  - The maximum GPA a student may earn is 4.8
- Core GPA
  - College often times don't care what you get in PE, electives, student aiding and so they look at only academics.
  - The Core GPA is made up of math, English, science, and social studies
  - Most times this is lower than the unweighted GPA

Example: A student might have the following: unweighted of 3.12; weighted of 3.44; and core of 2.5 (Will not be admissable to UNR/UNLV).

## ADVANCED HONORS DIPLOMA

Students planning to apply to universities with competitive admission requirements may pursue the CCSD Advanced Honors Diploma. The coursework in Honors, Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) classes is more intensive and rigorous. To qualify for the Advanced Honors Diploma, a student must complete the following twelve minimum requirements in Honors/AP/IB classes:

## Advanced Honors Diploma

- The Advanced Honors Diploma requires additional rigorous coursework beyond those required for the Advanced Diploma.
- Students will be required to fulfill the Advanced Diploma requirements and must complete the Honors, or Advanced Placement (AP) courses required of the Honors Course Program.
- Students must achieve a minimum of a 3.25 unweighted GPA and 3.85 weighted GPA.
- Students graduating in the Class of 2011 and beyond will be eligible for an Advanced Honors Diploma.

## LVA Academics Awards cont ...

#### LVA Academic Excellence Award

 Academic Excellence will be awarded for students who achieve 3.25 unweighted and 3.85 weighted or above GPA overall with no D's or F's on their transcript and at least one honors or AP course.

#### Valedictorian(s)

Valedictorian status is awarded to the student(s) with the highest grade point average (weighted GPA with Bonus Points) in the graduating class.

#### Salutatorian(s)

Awarded to students with the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest GPA (weighted GPA with Bonus Points) in the graduating class
