If you are a male ages 18 through 25 and living in the U.S., then you must register with Selective Service. It's the law. **ALL** males, even those who are undocumented, MUST register for Selective Service.

If you have a social security number, you can go to www.sss.gov and click on the Register Online button.





If you do not have a social security number, you can register at any post office.

What happens if you don't register?

- > You can be fined up to \$250,000 and/or serve up to 5 years in jail
- > You will be denied financial aide for college
- You will be denied citizenship if you are currently undocumented
- You will not be able to participate in federal job training programs
- You will not be able to work in a federal job
